Sandwell Council Leader and Cabinet Members recently visited SinglePoint to see the benefits of the West Midlands Combined Authority (WMCA) Connected Digital Services Programme in action. SinglePoint has been fortunate to receive a bank of electronic equipment to support community users in getting online and feeling confident to do so! 💻

More than 1,750 digital devices including Chromebooks and laptops have been given to residents and community organisations in Sandwell as part of a WMCA £3.8M project to help more people across the wider region get connected and get online.
